

Programme Structure

Duration: 6 Months

Intake: 10 Fellows Per Domain
(Biannually)

Academic Framework (ACR Model)

Application – Eligibility screening and academic suitability

Certification Assessment – Evaluation after 2 months online fellowship course completion

Research Publication – Research paper, review article, or policy-oriented output

Assessment & Completion Requirements

To receive the FNCI Fellowship Certificate, the Fellow must successfully complete:

- Online fellowship course and post-course assessment
- Approved survey work
- Mandatory research publication(s)
- Incomplete requirements will render the applicant ineligible for certification.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants should have:


A postgraduate or higher qualification in a relevant discipline (Master's, PhD, MD, DM, or equivalent professional qualification) with relevant academic, professional or research experience.

Certification & Recognition

FNCI Fellowship Certificate will be awarded during the Annual National Congress on Nutrition & Public Health (NCICON), providing national academic visibility and professional networking.

Fellowship Fee: ₹15,500 only/-
